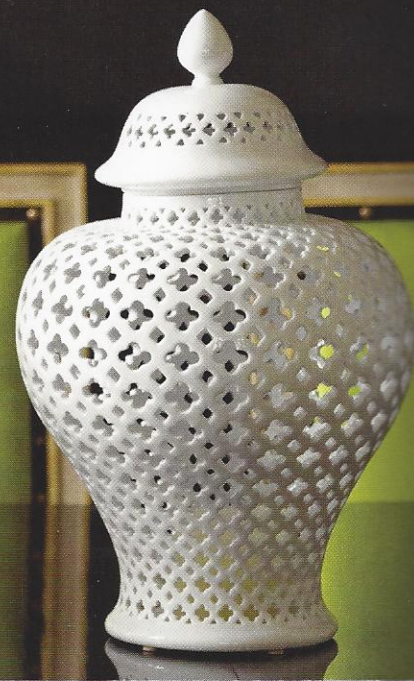

KARLA TEWES’ TURQUOISE IDEAS:

- “If you are worried that painting all four walls would be a bit much, you can introduce color on one focal wall for a wow factor, or paint a shape on the wall as a backdrop to a spectacular piece of art.”
- “Add some throw pillows or glass vases—my favorites are Blenko vases and lamps from the 1950s. I also love turquoise Foo dogs for a shelf or mantle, or some fun candle sleeves can jazz up an antique chandelier.”
- “Playing it safe on the color of your furniture doesn’t mean that you can’t be wild with the rug. My current favorites are overdyed Oriental carpets. A beautiful turquoise area rug laid over a rich wood floor is a stunning ground for any room.”
